Youth Leadership Symposium

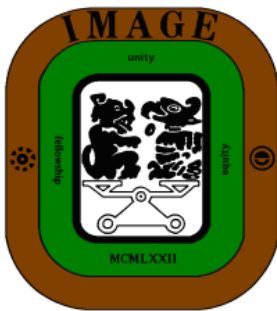
